



Robbery

Robbery is defined as the direct taking of property (including money) from a person through force, threat or intimidation. Robbery is a felony (crime punishable by a term in state or federal prison). "Armed robbery" involves the use of a gun or other weapon which can do bodily harm, such as a knife or club, and under most state laws carries a stiffer penalty (longer possible term) than robbery by merely taking. A term which is improperly used to describe thefts, shoplifting, and burglary (breaking and entering) expressed: "We've been robbed."
